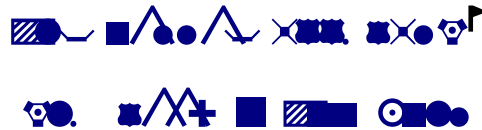




Get the Flu Shot!

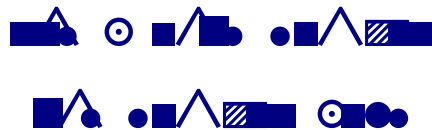


- FACT** every year, 1 in 6 Canadians are infected with influenza and 1,500 people die
- FACT** the effects of the flu can last 3 months or longer
